


OHCA's Dental Program provides a dental care benefit for adults 21 years of age and older and children under 21 years of age who are enrolled in SoonerCare (Traditional & Choice) program. Services for adults are limited to: Emergency Extractions, Smoking and Tobacco Use Sessation Counseling and Medical and Surgical services. The program provides the basic medically necessary treatment for children. Providers must have prior authorization for certains specified services before delivery of that service, unless the service is provided on an emergency basis.


Total SoonerCare and Insure Oklahoma Enrollment








OHCA's Perinatal Dental Program provides a dental care benefit for pregnant and postpartum women 21 years of age and older who are enrolled in SoonerCare (Traditional & Choice) program. The Perinatal Dental program includes examinations, radiography, cleanings (including scaling and planing), hygiene instruction and fillings. No major restorations (i.e. root canals, crowns, etc...) are covered. Extractions and tobacco cessation education continue to be covered dental benefits.


Members Qualifying for Perinatal Dental Services Since Inception (5/1/2007)


Members Qualifying for Perinatal Dental Services (SFY)




Members Receiving Perinatal Dental Services




Members Qualifying for Perinatal Dental Services by Age




Total Reimbursement
