


Oklahoma Uninsured Fast Facts October 2016

Below are the latest federal uninsured estimates for the state of Oklahoma. As the administrative agency of SoonerCare (Oklahoma Medicaid), the Oklahoma Health Care Authority constantly monitors the uninsured figures. Generally, our official source is the U.S. Census Bureau's American Community Survey, however, occasionally we are required to use other sources that provide alternate sub groupings such as employment, county, race, etc. For more detail you can go to www.okhca.org/research/data.



Oklahoma Children and Adults By Federal Poverty Level and Health Insurance Status








Distribution of Oklahoma's Uninsured Children and Adults by FPL (2015)
